Meeting was called to order at 6:20 pm. There was a motion made by Sue Bunnell with a second from Brad Kluttz to accept the minutes. After a vote the minutes were accepted as submitted.

Sue Bunnell read the Gospel reading from the NRSV, and Shannon Lawton read from The Message. Discussion within the group followed.

Discussion: Fr. Furman spoke about the graphic Tony Scalzitti has created. Kathleen Brady thanked Tony for his work. Fr. Furman discussed being mindful of being open to encouraging others to take part in activities throughout the parish.

Decisions: From Memorials- They would like to purchase the 14 unmounted Stations of the Cross to be displayed in the sanctuary during the Lenten Season. These will be mounted on wooden plaques by members of the parish who are woodworkers. There was a motion made by Larry Neal, with a second by Deb Yochum to approve the funds. This motion passed.
