

Minutes of the Vestry

The meeting was called to order by Fr. Furman at 6:15 pm. With a motion by Larry Neal, and a 2nd from Erin Ryan, to accept the minutes from the previous meeting, after a vote, the minutes were approved as submitted.

Gospel Reflection: Brad Kluttz read from the NRSV, and Larry Neal read the version from The Message. Discussion amongst the group followed.

Treasurer's Report: Laura presented the financial report to the group.

Total revenues for the month of \$58,702, are \$11,003 over budget for the month.

Total expenses for the month of \$44,411 are \$3,288 under budget for the month.

With a motion from Kathleen Brady and a 2nd from Tony Scalzitti to accept the March and April report's, after a vote, the motion passed and the Treasurer's Report was accepted into the minutes.

Fr. Furman passed out his Rector's report to the Vestry member's but due to the late hour, there was no discussion.

There being no further business, the meeting was called to a close shortly after 8:00pm, and ended with a prayer by Fr. Furman.
