

Minutes of the Vestry

The meeting was called to order at 6:15 pm. With a motion from Sandy Hemphill and a 2nd from Larry Neal, after a vote, the minutes were accepted as submitted.

Gospel Reflection: Suzann Adams read the passage from the NRSV. Sandy Hemphill read from The Message. Discussion among the group followed.

Fr. Furman at this point, shared with the group, and showed a PowerPoint presentation of the Vestry/SPY Mixer that had taken place. It was a powerful visual of the way we put God's words into actions and acts and works. Fr. Furman hopes to be able to share this with others in the parish as well.

Discussion/Decisions: Kitchen Remodeling- Discussion took place within the group. Vestry is requesting a more detailed list and perhaps a "phased timing" if possible. Larry Neal made a motion that states "The Vestry wants to know if the kitchen can be done in phases, the priority being appliances and pass-through. Request has been made for more detail for items such as cabinets/millwork, countertops and the Facilities Committee recommendations on these questions and a schedule for the work being done". Brad Kluttz offered a 2nd and after a vote, the motion passed.

First Aid Kits – Tony Scalzitti made a motion that the group spend under the limit allowed, with annual fee for these kits, to become part of budget. The Emergency Preparedness Group will enter into a relationship with Cintas for First Aid Kits". Mary Pauly offered a 2nd, and after a vote, the motion passed.

Treasurer's Report: Laura Foster presented the Financials to the group, and after a brief discussion, Sandy Hemphill made a motion, with a 2nd from Erin Ryan, to accept the report. After a vote, the motion passed, and the report was accepted into the minutes.

There being no further business, the meeting was called to a close at 7:40pm and ended with a prayer led by Fr. Furman.
