The meeting was called to order at approximately 6:15 p.m.

**Treasurer's Report:** Bill Hartzell presented his financial report to the group.

Income: Total revenues for the month of \$45,938 are approximately \$7,906 under budget

Expense: Total expenses for the month of \$42,943 are \$7,385 under budget.

With a motion from Al Mina and a 2<sup>nd</sup> from Jason Cheek there was a vote which passed. The Report was accepted into the Minutes.

**Rector's Report:**

Furman told the group about a possible staff change at ECF. There will be a new person appointed to work with us regarding our Capitol Campaign.

Advertising will stop regarding the Columbarium, it has been successful this far, and there is no need for further advertising.

Kanuga will begin offering new and different Church Weekends that they will host.

The new audio board is onsite and will be installed this week. UPDATE: this was installed and Sunday July 14<sup>th</sup> it was put into use for the first time. According to feedback, it is a success.
