Minutes of the Vestry May 11th, 2020

The meeting was called to order at 6:15 pm. This meeting was held via Zoom.

Emelyn made a motion, with a 2nd from Al, to accept the minutes of the April meeting. After a vote, the motion passed, and the minutes were approved.

Gospel Reflection: Fr. Furman read our scripture passage, this version was from the Message. There was discussion among the group following.

Discussion: Columbarium Placement... Discussion among the group took place regarding the various placement options for the new outdoor Columbarium, based upon input from the Columbarium committee.

The group will consider the various ideas and suggestions and speak with the Columbarium committee and ask the architect to prepare some rudimentary drawings of the various different options. This topic will be brought back to the table again next month.

Fr. Furman will speak with the chairs of the labyrinth, columbarium and grounds committees.

Funds to Outreach Advocates..... There was a motion from Tom and a 2nd from Beck to approve funds for Outreach Advocates, after a vote the monies were approved to be given.

Worship Updates.... Fr. Furman updated the group regarding the Diocesan decisions about worship and possible changes in the near future. Any action taken at St.Peters will be in accordance to and following of the Bishop's guidelines.

Decisions: Old Business- Pressure washing. We will revisit this as a Vestry next month.

Treasurer's Report: Bill presented the financials to the group. **Total revenues** for the month of \$85,422 are \$24,963 over budget for the month. **Total expense** for the month of \$47,887 are \$6947 under budget for the month.

Al made a motion and Jim a 2nd to adopt the report into the minutes. After a vote, the report was accepted.

There being no further business, the meeting called to an end and we closed with a prayer from Fr. Furman.
