

St Peter's Episcopal Church  
Minutes of the Vestry June 8th, 2020

The meeting was held via Zoom.

**Attendance:** Fr. Furman, Dexter, Jim P, Tom P., Malissa, April, Kyle C., Emelyn, Bobbie, James K, Al, Bill H., Shelley. Beck could not be at the meeting.

The meeting was called to order at 6:15 pm. The first order of business was acceptance of the minutes of the previous meeting. April made a motion, with a 2nd from Bobbie, that the minutes be accepted. After a vote, minutes were accepted.

**Gospel Reflection:** Fr. Furman read the passage and discussion among the group occurred afterwards.

**Discussion:** Worship Plans: Tom P informed the Vestry, that a group of Vestry members had rearranged the tables in the Pavilion, to accommodate social distancing for a time when the Bishop approves restarting services with a limited amount of people per service.

Columbarium Placement: Fr. Furman began by speaking about the previous meeting's discussions regarding placement of the new Columbarium. After discussion within the group, a motion was made by Malissa, with a 2nd from Emelyn: To proceed with the L-shaped Columbarium plans adjacent to the Education wing- contingent upon a satisfactory rendering of the project, with both elevation and plan views. The Vestry approves spending not to exceed \$2000.00 for this. After a vote, the motion passed.

**Old Business:** Pressure Washing: The Vestry wishes to go ahead with this, but will defer for another time, as to date and cost.

Stewardship Reports: Kyle C. reported on the Facilities meeting updates

Malissa reported plans for Children's programs are in the works

Emelyn gave an organ update.

Treasurer's Report: Bill gave the financial update to the group.

Income: Total revenues for the month of \$57,289 are \$13,626 over budget.

Expense: Total expenses for month of \$30,067 are \$8,814 under budget.

With a motion from Jim P and a 2nd from Al, after a vote, the report was adopted into the minutes

Rector's Report: Fr. Furman took this time to explain to the group the many things affecting our parish and diocese.

There being no further business, the meeting was closed with prayer at 8:00 pm.
