

St Peter's Episcopal Church Minutes of the Vestry

July 2020

Attendance: Fr. Furman, Bobbie, Beck, Jim P, Dexter, April, Malissa, Rhys, Kyle C, Emelyn, Al, Tom P, Bill, Shelley

The meeting was held via zoom, and called to order at 6:15 pm.

Acceptance of Minutes: With a motion from Jim and a 2nd from Malissa, the minutes were approved after a vote.

Gospel Reflection: Fr. Furman read from the NRSV. There was group discussion that followed.

Discussion:

Worship Update: Fr. Furman spoke about the upcoming in-person worship plans that have been made, regarding the souns system, altar guild, cleaning, seating etc.

Turnbull Trust: The vestry has 12 months to make a decision on how to allocate those funds in the amount of \$6800.

ECF: Charlie Fisher, our ECF consultant spoke with Fr. Furman. ECF is changing their form of involvement in capital campaigns.

Old Business:

Coluubarium Placement: The Columbarium Committee offered the Vestry further suggestions for the placement of the Columbarium.

There was a motion made by Beck- "The Vestry accepts the counterproposal from the Columbarium Committee for general placement and removal of the tree in question, change in perimeter fencing etc)." Rhys offered a 2nd. Beck and Rhys will serve as liasons between the vestry and committee. After a vote, the motion passed.

New Business:

Termite Bond has lapsed. A 10 year product is recommended which has a \$125 yearly charge. This will be taken up at the next meeting. In the meantime, Kyle will contact the company with some questions.

Treasurer's Report:

Bill presented the financials to the group.

Income: Total revenues for month of \$31,976 are \$13,938 under budget.

Expense: Total expenses for month of \$44,354 are \$3,315 under budget.

April made a motion with a 2nd from Tom, and after a vote the reoprt was adopted into the minutes.

Rector's Report:

Furman shared a thank you letter from Rosemarie Gerstenberger.

Sunday school has been well attended.

Virtual worship has gone well.

EFM is looking for new members.

Tom, Al, Emelyn and Jim will be rotating off Vestry- new nominees will be needed to fill those vacancies.

Tom read a deposition to the group per the Bishop's orders.

There being no further business, the meeting was closed with prayer by Fr. Furman at 7:45 pm.
